













Nansloe Writing Sequence



Week 1  	Non-fiction Text immersion - children learn and internalise the text using a text map and actions. Text analysis - Investigate grammatical features and layout of text. Investigate similar models. Vocabulary building. Short burst grammar and spelling activities to support work in week 2.	Narrative Story immersion - children learn and internalise the story using a story map and actions. Develop an understanding of characters, setting, plot/story structure and dialogue in the story. Investigate high quality examples of characters and settings. Short burst grammar and spelling activities to support work in week 2.
Week 2 Innovate    	Planning based on structure of learnt text. Box-up and planning structure Teacher modelled writing Have a go - daily marking ladders to support writing of sections of text. Reflect using marking ladder Deep marking by teacher Teacher modelled editing of children's work using visualiser. Children edit and improve using 'better in blue' pens.	Planning key elements for innovation - boxed up method, story mountain, ideas for characters and setting, changing story map. Teacher modelled writing Have a go - daily marking ladders to support writing of sections of text.
