These are spellings that the children are expected to spell and use within their writing by the end of Year 6.

PE will take place every **Tuesday** and **Friday** afternoon so please ensure your child has their PE kit in school for these lessons.

Homework

Homework will be set on a Friday and submitted the following Friday. Tasks will include spellings, grammar, maths and reading. Further details on topic homework projects will be sent out in due course. Daily reading is also very important so please encourage your child to read as reading for pleasure is so important for language and vocabulary development.
