Dear Parents

This half term our topic is called Animal Safari. We will launch the topic with a visit from Mark's Ark. This will be an amazing opportunity to get close-up to several incredible animals and insects including giant bird-eating spiders, snakes, lizards, and birds of prey. In addition, your child will learn about incredible animals that live worldwide. They will explore various animal habitats and compare the animals that live there with animals in their locality. They will learn how to care for pets and what all animals need to grow, survive, and stay happy and healthy. They will explore animal features and find out how they survive in the wild. They will compare the ways that animals are similar and different.

Each week we hold 'show and tell' sessions with the children. These provide the children with an opportunity to practise their 'speaking and listening' skills within a group situation. We find we get a much better response if the children have something specific to show rather than just bringing in one of their favourite toys. To support this, we ask that you upload a picture on Tapestry (their online learning journey) or bring their creation into Nursery so we can share this together as a class. This is of course completely optional, so please dip in and out as you are able. Please see attached the weekly topics for reference.

Finally, As the warmer weather hopefully approaches, please ensure that children have their sun cream applied before the start of their session and that they bring a named sun hat with them.
